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DEVELOP YOUR CRITICAL READING SKILLS




The Nonfiction Reading and Writing program helps students develop the critical reading skills they need to tackle high-level nonfiction articles in newspapers and magazines. Students learn to read actively and identify the main idea, argument, style, and tone of texts. They also learn to use context clues and prefixes, suffixes, and roots to determine the meaning of unfamiliar words they encounter while reading.

ENHANCE YOUR DISCUSSION SKILLS



Through in-class discussion and debates on the various issues presented in the articles, students practice essential discussion skills, such as actively listening to their classmates, responding to their classmates' ideas, and supporting their own ideas with evidence from the texts. They learn to formulate their own opinions and express themselves in an eloquent manner.

IMPROVE YOUR WRITING ABILITY



Writing assignments, including summaries and critical analyses of the articles, provide students with ample opportunity to practice expressing their thoughts in a clear and effective way.
